REHEARSALS:

- As a member of the LDA cast you are required at EVERY rehearsal. If you have a clash of commitments with good reasoning or are sick, you will need to let THE OFFICE <u>and</u> YOUR TEACHER know as soon as possible.
- All times will be kept to as much as possible. Please be understanding if we run a little late as we are working with a large number of students and many variables. Mother helps and teachers have parent/caregiver contacts if needed. Please pick up children promptly.
- Please bring food and drink, however there is to be no eating or drinking in costumes except water. No nuts are allowed backstage.
- Please bring cards, games, colouring books, activity book (pencils only no pens) to keep students occupied.
- At times, items may be rehearsed out of order. Depending on rehearsal order and run time, students may not be required to stay the full length of their scheduled time. We endeavour to get students finished ASAP, Mother helps will be your first port of call to find out finish time and they will not leave until all students in their group have been collected.
- Please be ready at least 10 minutes before you are required to dance, including costumes; hair & make up if required; and warmed up ready to dance. Missing dancers disrupts rehearsals and causes confusion.
- Do not leave any rehearsal without first checking with your 'Mother Help'.
- Only Mother Helps may observe rehearsals, and at the theatre only 2 Mother Helps are able to be side stage as this area can easily get crowded. No phones side of stage. No extra children may attend rehearsals or be backstage due to space limitations & security.

- No parental photos or videos may be taken during rehearsals or performances. Backstage photos may be taken for keepsakes, but please be mindful of others privacy. Nothing should be posted on social media before the show, unless it has been shared by LDA first as promotional material.

PERFORMANCES:

- During shows, please remain in dressing room at all times until called for your item(s) and the finale.
- Please leave valuables at home. <u>No responsibility is taken by LDA for cash or valuables at The Studio, Rototuna High School, or Clarence Street Theatre.</u>
- For security reasons the stage door will be locked at various times.
- At the theatre, dancers & 'Mother Helps' will be required to sign in at the security desk (for OSH requirements) and make their way to their designated dressing room. On the first day of rehearsals we will arrange for senior students to show the younger dancers to their dressing rooms so they know where they need to be.

HAIR & MAKEUP:

- <u>Please apply make up at home.</u> Foundation, blusher and a bright red lipstick works well under the lights (no colourstay). Highlight eyes where possible students with fair eyebrows need to emphasise them with pencil. Examples will be given out to Mother Helps, and available at the theatre.
- Students should bring their lipstick and hair gear with them for touch ups, brush, fine tooth comb, pins, grips, hair gel/spray, hair ties.
- A costume sheet will be given out after dress rehearsal with hair and costume requirements. Please have all items ready for the theatre.

Mother Help Information!

Dear Caregivers - Please read carefully: We Need You!

Our end of year show is an incredible opportunity for all our children to perform on stage. It is a fantastic event and every year we have a great team of helpers. We have put class lists up at the back of studio 1. Please come in and put your name beside your child's class if you can help.

The number of helpers depends on group size, if your name is not on the list unfortunately you are not able to turn up and help at the theatre. Not all of the Mother Helps need to be at each rehearsal - we are aware that a lot of parents are working therefore may struggle with the mid-week rehearsals, therefore please liaise with your team to make a roster so there is enough help.

If it is your first time as a "Mother Help", here's a little more information for you. The students need help getting in and out of their costumes, making sure they are ready to go on stage and need occupying when they are not on stage at both the rehearsal space and backstage at the theatre. Plenty of information will be passed on to you through Mother Help packs, so you can know exactly what is going on.

LDA caters for a large number of dancers therefore we need to keep the following in mind when it comes to rehearsals at the theatre. Due to fire regulations at the theatre, unless you have signed up at the studio to be a Mother Help, you will not have to access backstage at Clarence St Theatre, including extra children. Mini Movement & Beginner Ballet parents are the only exception to this as we acknowledge each young child may need their parent. These classes may still wish to buddy up with another parent in the same class to reduce numbers and provide you with an opportunity to watch from the audience.

In regards to Mother Helps, we ask that no fathers or brothers be backstage, due to the fact the children are changing often. If you have a problem with access and need to contact your child please let Kaye know via the senior dressing room.

We look forward to another great show and appreciate your assistance in making this run as smoothly as possible. We cannot do this without your help so thank you! The children really appreciate your help and you will enjoy meeting some wonderful people.
